

The CAF will be prepared to simultaneously

- -Defend Canada, including responding concurrently to multiple domestic emergencies in support of civilian authorities;
- -Meet its NORAD obligations;
- -Meet commitments to NATO Allies under Article 5 of the North Atlantic Treaty;
- -Contribute to international peace and stability
- (4 sustained deployments, 3 time-limited deployments, scalable response to disasters & NEO)

Army Readiness:

- 6 x Combat Units
- 4x Immediate Response Units
- 5x Canadian Rangers Patrol Groups
- 1x Airborne Support Group
- 10x Territorial Battle Groups
- 4x Arctic Response Company Groups

Scalable Enablers:



Concurrent Operations Worldwide:

- -Contribute to international peace and stability
- 2 of 2 sustained deployments of ~500-850 pers (Op IMPACT & Op REASSURANCE)
- 1 of 2 sustained deployments of ~200 pers (Op UNIFIER)
- Several time-limited deployments of ~300 pers total (Op PROJECTION, Op ARTEMIS)
- 2 time-limited deployments (6-9 months) of ~500 pers total (Op PRESENCE (Africa), Op CARIBBE)
- Conplans RENAISSANCE and ANGLE
- Capacity building

Challenges:

- Force Generation of personnel
- Sustainment of equipment/assets
- Theatre opening teams and JTF/ATF support groups
