

AUTOBIOGRAPHY –Master Corporal Mader

At the age of 20, Master Corporal Mader Joined the Canadian Forces on 23rd July 1983 At the CF RC Edmonton as a Traffic Tech, and was stationed at 1 Air Movements Unit in Edmonton, AB.

On the 20th July 1987 he was posted to 1 Canadian Forces Supply Depot, Downsview ON, and was promoted to Corporal shortly after. He remained here until November 1991 when he took a voluntary release.

In November 1995 he rejoined the Canadian Forces at CF RC London Det, Kitchener, ON, and attended the recruit school St-Jean, QC. From there Private Mader went to the RCR Battle School in Meaford, ON in February 1996. In June 1996, after Battle school he was posted to 3 RCR Petawawa, ON and promoted to Cpl on the 26 November 1997.

On the 24 September 2001, Cpl Mader transferred from the Infantry to the Engineers as a Water Fuels & Environment Tech at CFSME Burton, NB. From there he was posted to CBF Kingston, ON in June 2002. MCpl Mader completed a tour OP ATHENA, Kabul Afghanistan from February to August 2005 where he received the GSC ISAF medal.

In December 2005 He was promoted to Master Corporal and July 2006 he was posted to the ASU in CFB Edmonton, AB. In July 2007 MCpl Mader was posted CFB North Bay.

MCpl Mader is retiring after 21 years service moving to Lions Head in the Northern Bruce Peninsula, ON for his future endeavours.
