

RETIREMENT - SGT TR MILLER, CONST TECH

1. AFTER 16 PLUS YEARS OF LOYAL AND DEDICATED SERVICE TO THE CROWN AND COUNTRY, SERGEANT TRENT MILLER WILL RETIRE FROM THE CANADIAN MILITARY ENGINEERS AND THE CF ON 17 NOVEMBER 2008. SGT MILLER JOINED THE ARTILLERY RESERVES ON 25 APRIL 1989 AND SERVED UNTIL HE TRANSFERRED TO THE REGULAR FORCE ON 16 JUNE 1995. HE SERVED AT THE FIELD ARTILLERY SCHOOL UNTIL OCTOBER 1999 WHEN HE RECEIVED AN OCCUPATIONAL TRANSFER TO CONSTRUCTION TECH. UPON COMPLETION OF TRAINING HE WAS TRANSFERRED TO 4 ACT 4 ESR. ON 31 MARCH 2004 SGT MILLER WAS POSTED TO CFB ESQUIMALT. DURING HIS YEARS AS A CONSTRUCTION TECH AT 4 ACT 4 ESR SGT MILLER COMPLETED TWO DEPLOYMENTS TO ERITREA OF 46 AND 52 DAYS FOR CAMP CONSTRUCTION AND TEARDOWN. WHILE AT CFB ESQUIMALT SGT MILLER PARTICIPATED IN A 2 MONTH CONSTRUCTION TAL AS TFA ESTABLISHED AT KANDAHAR AIRFIELD (KAF).
