Sgt Daniel Arseneault, CD1, will retire from the CF in August 25th, 2010 after 23 years of loyal services.

Sgt Arseneault began its career in 1986 as reservist in the 2RNBR as infantryman. In the 1990s, he joined the Regular Forces as Naval Electronic Sensor Operator, sailing with HMCS Algonquin as well as the HMCS Iroquois before making a change of career in 1994 as Artilleryman.
